In the summer of '08 she competed at Gospel Music Association's "Music in the Rockies" where she finished 5th in the nation. In 2008 she recorded her first semi-professional album of all original songs. Her original song "Fourteen" has been played numerous times on Seattle's Spirit 105.3fm. Her music also plays on local radio 105.7 The Jet, Sunny 102.1, and Big Foot Country 93.7. Ericka travels with a small band doing acoustic concerts. She plays guitar, piano and ukulele. Her husband Mattaniah accompanies with acoustic guitar, accordion, ukulele and a Cajon. Their good friend Jeff Perrin plays bass and cello in the band.
